SECRETARY'S REPORT: MSC: Swiontek-Albrecht to approve minutes of the October meeting as written.

<u>TREASURER'S REPORT</u>: The October 31st report was presented for review. <u>MSC</u>: Schramm-Robinson to approve the report as presented.

<u>OCTOBER BILLS</u>: <u>MSC</u>: Albrecht-Robinson to approve payment of all bills presented. Juve discussed the idea of paying credit card invoices prior to board approval to avoid late fees. School Psychology Grant Opportunity: Juve reported that the School Psychology Grant Opportunity through Minot State fell through and is no longer available. He reported that there is a possibility UVSE could be approved for the ND School Psychology Service Grant, which is a similar grant also through Minot State and will also credential a participant in the area of School Psychology. The financial obligation of this grant would include supplementing the participant's 3rd year internship salary beyond what the grant does not pay, as well as hire a replacement for the participant's teaching position. Discussion followed. With those financial obligations in mind, Juve asked the board for approval to apply for this grant. M/S: Schramm-Albrecht to go forward with the process. Motion carried. 4-1, Swiontek opposed.
