- Juve noted that three Intent to Hire letters were sent out to international teachers for the 2025-2026 School Year. Two of the three teachers have verbally accepted with the third teacher declining the offer. Juve asked for contract approval for Maribeth Cardenas who will serve in the Grafton School District and Gina Aninon who will serve in the Drayton School District. STRATEGIZING FOR NEGOTIATIONS: General discussion was held regarding upcoming negotiations. The impact of upcoming budgetary expense and revenue considerations were discussed. Sample spreadsheets of various salary and benefit packages were reviewed. M/S: Swiontek-Ford to offer the negotiating teachers a total package increase not to exceed \$185,000 over the next two years. Discussion followed. Motion failed 2-4 by roll call vote. Yes: Swiontek, Ford Opposed: Salyer, Schramm, Robinson, Albrecht.
